Context

This deliverable is part of the MORPHEUS project which is a European initiative financed under the 6th FP and addresses innovative solutions for embedded computing based on dynamically reconfigurable platform and tools.

MORPHEUS project aims at satisfying embedded systems new demanding requirements in terms of computing performance, cost-efficient development, functional flexibility and sustainability by developing a global solution based on a modular heterogeneous SOC platform providing dynamically reconfigurable computing completed by a software oriented design flow and a consistent toolset.

MORPHEUS is a 3-year project started in 2006 and gathering all the required expertise from several countries: academics, industrials, SMEs.

Aim of the deliverable

The goal of this deliverable is the comparison of requested dissemination events coming from the DoW and metrics that have been defined there and the actual attended and organized events. Finally it is shown that the requests and tasks are met. In general MORPHEUS dissemination activities is the promotion of the advanced technology of dynamically reconfigurable computing to the widest community of potential users.

Content of the deliverable

This deliverable describes the different tools (press release, flyer, book, web site) that are used within MORPHEUS, evaluating also their impact on the dissemination effectiveness. The press release is described, reporting about its motivation and impact. The flyer is examined, reporting where it was distributed. For the MORPHEUS BOOK that is soon available at Springer, an outline is given. The MORPHEUS web site is described, including its motivation and planned future activity; also a set of references to MORPHEUS from other web sites of the project partners is shown.

The core of the deliverable is a chapter about the publications and presentations; it is aimed at documenting the amount of dissemination performed and to demonstrate that it fulfils the expected milestones and the list of actions. Most of the emphasis is put on the description of the major dissemination events such as UNICAD workshop, DATE conference, the AMWAS, the CASTNESS and the ECSI workshop.
